Demolition of Residential Structure

MN State Building Code Chapter 1300.0120

The following items are required:

- 1. Obtain a residential demolition permit to demolish any building code regulated structure.
- 2. Obtain a septic system permit to pump and properly abandon the septic system, per MN Rules Chapter 7080.2500. *Provide SSTS Abandonment Form*. Septic contractors must be licensed.
- 3. Call Gopher-One at 800-252-1166 or 651-454-0002 prior to any digging on the site.
- **4.** Wells shall be capped and sealed by certified personnel, per MN Department of Health (MDH) regulations Chapter 4725. For more information call MDH at 800-383-9808 or 651-201-5797.
- **5.** Any hazardous wastes, chemicals, or dangerous materials such as asbestos shall be identified with the permit application and can only be removed by authorized personnel.
- 6. Prior to starting any demolition call your utility companies to disconnect all utility services.
- **7.** If the structure is connected to city utility services, call the city public works department for requirements to disconnect sewer and water supplies.
- **8.** Construction debris shall be contained on site during demolition and removed to an approved disposal facility before scheduling a final inspection.
- **9.** Erosion control measures are required for the duration of the project until natural vegetation is in place. All construction material shall be removed. No on-site burial of debris is allowed.

10. Two inspections are required:

- Site inspection, after all debris is removed but prior to any backfill;
- Final inspection, after backfill is complete and site is restored to pre-construction condition.
- **11.** Final grading shall ensure proper drainage and that erosion control is maintained.
